Demographics

The Lake Norman Citizen serves a vibrant and affluent region that is poised for continued growth and prosperity. With Lake Norman acting as the fuel that drives the area's economic engine, the north Mecklenburg / south Iredell region continues to attract new residents and new businesses. The Citizen is an active partner with your business while serving as the platform for providing news and information as well as a community forum for the exchange of ideas.

Nearly 120,000 residents of the towns of Cornelius, Davidson, Huntersville and Mooresville call the Lake Norman area home, truly the size of a medium-size city itself. While the residents of each identify with their individual town, they are also in essence citizens of the entire Lake Norman region. Because of proximity and access, they may live in one town and work in another, but they shop, dine and use services in all four.

The Citizen serves a region in which the median household income for a family exceeds \$95,000, according to the most recent estimates of the U.S. Census Bureau. As an indication of the region's affluence, on April 22, 2009, the average listing price of a home in Huntersville was \$320,000, in Davidson \$396,000, Cornelius \$496,000 and in Mooresville \$226,662 according to figures provided by Trulia.com. Rather than drive to Charlotte or elsewhere, these residents prefer to spend their money locally.
